### Warkworth Castle & Hermitage

Be king or gueen for the day in one of the strongest and most impressive fortresses in northern England. Warkworth Castle stands proudly on the hilltop overlooking the pretty town. Climb the cross-shaped keep and take in breathtaking views of the river and coast beyond.

The castle was featured in Shakespeare's Henry IV and its most famous owners were the Percy family, still the Dukes of Northumberland today. Enjoy a riverside walk and boat ride to discover the secret Hermitage carved out of the rock face. Step into the unique and atmospheric living guarters of a solitary holy man.



### Lindisfarne Priory

Cross the causeway to the holy island of Lindisfarne and wander through the serene priory ruins. The spiritual home of the famous Lindisfarne Gospels and one-time burial place of the revered Saint Cuthbert, this priory is a truly tranquil island escape.

Step into the story of its grisly Viking past and marvel at the intricate stone carvings and dramatic rainbow arch. In the museum, see the famous Viking Raider Stone and delve deeper into the lives of the people who lived at the priory.




Aydon Castle




