

Walk 4 Railway, Watermill and Woodland

This walk is notable for its views westward, the original track of the Shincliffe to Sunderland railway almost hidden in broadleaved woodland, and the remains of Shincliffe Mill. (It can be muddy underfoot)

Walk 3 Schools, Collieries and Lepers

High Shincliffe with the old Parochial School built in 1841, the pit heap (now a wildlife habitat), the wagonway from the colliery to the main line, the sites of Whitwell Village and the colliery, and the ancient Christ's Hospital of Sherburn founded in 1181 for the care of lepers, all await the visitor.
